And this is when you find yourself confronted with the shy and retiring Leo, the reckless Capricorn, the uncaring Cancer, the cold and unemotional Pisces.

This is a rather long-winded way of advising you to tread a little carefully and don't simply assume that because a guy was born on November 5th, he's going to respond to your advances like a wild animal. Do a little research first. Get to know the guy. Take his sensual temperature, as it were. To quote the great American poet, Robert Frost, "Don't ever take a fence down until you know why it was put up."

SEX AND THE GEMINI MAN

An Overview

The Gemini man is a creature of pure energy, bounding from one activity to the next with an enthusiasm that can be captivating or utterly infuriating, depending on your own personality! He is a highly social animal and, because he is intelligent and quick-witted, he is frequently in demand. Gemini men tend to be great communicators and love nothing more than engaging in long, deep and fascinating conversations. They possess the rare ability to flit between viewpoints making them very tolerant and accepting of other people's views. It's difficult to argue with a Gemini man because he is unlikely to utterly reject any argument, finding merit in any viewpoint. As such, he can be a great broker in any conflict. The Gemini man's prime failing is a tendency to become bored very easily.

What does Sex Mean to the Gemini Man?

If you haven't already guessed, the Gemini man is sexually adventurous, not to mention a little inappropriate. If you're *also* sexually adventurous and a little inappropriate, that's great. You're a perfect match. If you tend toward the more prudish and conservative end of the erotic spectrum (Capricorn or Virgo), you may have problems keeping your Gemini man entertained between the sheets (or between the whatever, wherever). And make no mistake, for the Gemini man, sex is very much about entertainment. It is a recreational activity to which he attaches no emotional significance. Sex for the Gemini man is sex; there is little or no danger of him confusing it with anything else. That isn't to say that sex is a purely physical activity for the Gemini man. For him, sex takes place as much in the head as it does in the bed (or the whatever, wherever). What you say or how you act is as likely to turn him on as much as the way you look and the things you do. Sexual roleplay, whether it's dressing up or something more complex, elaborate and quite possibly hazardous, is a prerequisite for the Gemini man.

But make no mistake, sex isn't part of an emotional tangle for the Gemini man and it doesn't have to be romantic, as it does, say, for the Pisces man. So, If you're looking for an uncomplicated and thrilling one-night stand (and there's absolutely nothing wrong with that), the Gemini man is the perfect specimen for your purposes. That isn't to say he's incapable of being a one-gal man; he is. He's just incapable of being a one-position, one-venue man.

If you're unwilling to experiment and inject a little fun and naughtiness into your sex life, the Gemini man is likely to become bored, and a bored Gemini man won't stick around for very long.

However, this doesn't mean you have to constantly reinvent yourself for his purposes. Small, subtle changes are sufficient: a different location, a rearranging of the 'order of things', or even a new perfume are all enough to keep the more moderate Gemini man on his toes.

The extreme Gemini man is a different matter entirely, of course. You either follow him deep into the world of the sexually weird and wonderful or there's every chance he'll head off there with someone else. But the extremes of *all* the zodiac males present a dizzying array of problems and challenges. Plus, the extreme types tend to be exceptional. You're much more likely to encounter a moderately audacious and exploratory Gemini man. And, quite frankly, who wouldn't want to give that a try?

What's in it for You?

So, what's the Gemini man like in bed? Good question. But a hard one to answer, because, unlike most of the men of the zodiac, 'sex' and 'bed' are not synonymous to the Gemini man. In the Gemini man's thesaurus, 'sex' is synonymous with 'car', 'cemetery', 'gym', public convenience', 'Jacuzzi' or 'ornamental garden', but rarely 'bed'.

Rather than ask what the Gemini man is like in *bed*, it would be just as appropriate to ask, What's the Gemini man like in the Anglo-Saxon Literature section of the public library? Or, What's the Gemini man like on the Spider-Man ride at Universal Studios? Or, What's the Gemini man like in the crypt of the Sacré Cœur whilst a full mass is going on overhead? Or, What's the Gemini man like on the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository?

If left unchecked, the Gemini man's penchant for experimentation can become a rather selfish pursuit, as he delves ever deeper in his quest for pleasure. The secret is to make *you* his experiment. If you let him know you have an open mind and are willing to try anything once, he will be only too keen to make you his little project. He will go to extremes if necessary, and if you encourage him, to bring you to screaming orgasm.

The Gemini man's erogenous zones are his fingers and fingertips, so he will be aroused by the textures he encounters whilst exploring your body. Stimulating your clitoris with his fingertips and feeling the gush of moisture as he strokes will drive him as wild as it will you.

What Works for Him?

Initiating sex with a Gemini man is relatively simple. He's one of the zodiac's great communicators. So, unlike the Taurus man, who needs a written invitation signed by at least two witnesses to be delivered by FedEx, the Gemini man will respond to subtle hints.

Moving things onto the next level is just as easy. Words are as likely to have an aphrodisiac effect on him as any action. Telling him what turns *you* on will have the effect of turning *him* on. Read an erotic passage from a book "you just happen to be reading" and he'll be yours. If in doubt play with those hypersensitive fingers of his. Rubbing the tip of your finger against the phalange of his fingers will work every time. Sucking his fingers drive him crazy.

What constitutes great sex for the Gemini man is likely to be anything he hasn't already tried. This can make first time sex with a Gemini man seem a little daunting. However, you needn't worry, because the fact that he's having sex with you for the first time will be novelty enough and more.

If you're looking to make sex with the Gemini man something he's unlikely to forget in a hurry, you'll need to engage his mind and imagination as much as his body. Sex in silence is not for the Gemini man. Nor is sex in the dark. Keep the lights on. Let him see your body. Let him see what you're doing to his body. Whatever his does to you, tell him how it's making you feel. Tell him what you want to do to him and what you want him to do to you. Shocking and taboo language will definitely light his fuse. Taboo words, in particular, are effective, representing, as they do, a kind of experiment in thought and language, a reaching for extremes. But remember to pace yourself. You don't want to come across like something from *The Exorcist...* at least not right away. Start off with a few encouraging sounds, then introduce some gentler nouns and adjectives, then, breathless with excitement, let loose a few choice and savoury expletives, before looping back to those encouraging sounds and gentler nouns and adjectives. Let language become an honest expression of how your feeling. In short, sometimes a penis is a penis. And sometimes, it's a *cock*.

Equally, roleplay is important. Once your relationship is established (assuming you want it to, and who am I to judge?) you can indulge in roleplaying sessions so elaborate they may require an Oscar-winning crew of set decorators, costume designers and special effects technicians. Early in a relationship or for the purpose of a one-night stand or consciously time-limited romance, it can be enough to behave unexpectedly. If you're a naturally quiet person, to suddenly take your

Gemini man firmly in hand will spark his interest. Similarly, if you're normally confident and extrovert, to become spontaneously coy will excite his mind.

When it comes to sexual positions, pretty much anything goes with the Gemini man. There isn't a single position in this book that he'll shy away from. In fact, there are several we wouldn't dare include in this book he'd be only too eager to try out. However, if this is your first time with him, I'd recommend a position which will enable you to whisper sweet nothings (not to mention virtue-corroding filth) into his only-too-eager ears.

This is a position I like to call the 'Speak Easy'. Now, we're going to give you two versions of this position. Both are ostensibly the same but the first version is for those of you who are a little on the shy side and the second version is for the sexually extrovert amongst you. If you're generally a lights off, wriggling out of your underwear under the covers kind of person, then the first version is definitely for you. If you've ever won thunderous applause and wolf whistles for your burlesque dancing routines, then the second version is for you.

Firstly, this position is far more suited to a sofa than a bed, so it'll meet the approval of your Gemini man right away, simply because the action doesn't take place in the tried-and-tested, been-there-done-that environment of the bedroom. Straddle your Gemini man as he sits upright on the sofa, clamping your thighs tightly to his pelvis. Your heals should be pressed against his thighs. There should be something *desperate* and *grasping* in the way you cling onto him, demonstrating an uncontrollable sexual hunger.

You'll find this position offers a very different sensation to a typical on-top position where the man is lying down, with the angle of entry of the penis resulting in very different areas of the vagina receiving maximum stimulation.

Clothing is optional here. You can go for the mostly clothed quickie or get completely naked. Up to you. Both will appeal to the Gemini man, but the impulsive nature of the quickie approach may just clinch it in appealing to his adventurous nature.

Once the action is underway, you can very much set the pace. However, if you get tired, your Gemini man can easily take over, planting his feet firmly on the ground and thrusting upwards into you. If you both thrust at the same time, the depth of penetration can be fairly mind-blowing!

If you think you can stand some *extra-deep* penetration, try raising your knees up to just beneath his armpits and placing your feet flat on the sofa. This creates a very intense angle of entry and allows for additional penetration.

Given the fact that you're facing each other, you can treat him to some of that dirty talk he's particularly fond of. Plus, he'll be delighted by the noises you make and your facial expressions during those moments of deep penetration.

Remember, the Gemini man's erogenous zone is his fingers. Sucking his fingers whilst you ride him will be an experience he never forgets. He'll also be particularly aroused if you place his hands on your breasts and squeeze his hands. He'll love the fact that you're fondling your own breasts by proxy; and the sensation of both your breasts and hands against his super-sensitive fingers will drive him crazy.

Now for the burlesque dancers amongst you... In the lounge (bedrooms are for sleeping, as far as the Gemini man is concerned), undress your Gemini man. Tell him it's strictly hands-off until you say otherwise. Push him down onto the sofa then, slowly and teasingly, begin to undress. If he attempts to stand, keep him in place with a firm foot. He'll enjoy your dominance. Once naked, step onto the sofa, on foot either side of him -- let him have a good eyeful! -- then descend onto his penis. Like I said, not one for the shy and retiring!
